Main Duties

Hours of work will be between 5 and 10 hours per week from January to August 2022, with possibility of extension. It is anticipated that all/most work will be done remotely. This position pays \$22.50/hour. The incumbent must currently be registered as a student at the University of Guelph and may be from any program. Training will be provided to the selected candidate.
